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Subject Equal handling of start notification for CPAs and project activities

Dear Mr. Maosheng Duan,

Honorable Members of the CDM Executive Board,

The PD Forum welcomes the effort which is being made by the Board and the Secretariat to improve the rules related to Programmes of Activities (PoAs). However, we believe that it is important to revise one of the rules introduced in EB 70 to harmonize the rules for programmes and project activities.

According to paragraph 107 of the *CDM Validation and Verification Standard (version 3, EB 70),* PPs can demonstrate that CDM was seriously considered in the decision to implement a project when its starting date is within 180 days of the prior consideration notification.

In contrast, in line with paragraph 193 of the same document, the start date of any CPA needs to be <u>on or</u> <u>after</u> the start date of the PoA, which is determined either through the prior consideration notification or the date of publication of the PoA-DD for global stakeholder consultation.

This means that for project activities, the earliest date at which_implementation/construction/real action begins can be up to six months before the prior consideration notification. This measure allows some flexibility for project owners who are not aware of all the administrative requirements of the CDM when they start their projects.

For PoAs, the six month flexibility before the date of notification is not allowed. The starting date of the first CPA needs to be on or after the PoA prior consideration notification.

The PD Forum would like to see the approach harmonized since there is no reason why PoA rules should be different from those of project activities regarding starting dates. Thus, we suggest that paragraph 193 of the *CDM Validation and Verification Standard* is revised to require CPAs to start <u>within 180</u> days of the start date of the PoA (meaning up to 6 months before or anytime after the prior notification form).
